# **REOPENING OF SCHOOLS**

Citizens say Ebola prevention measures are strictly respected in homes and public places such as schools and markets. However, they claim there are fewer health workers who could monitor its effective implementation.

# **POST EBOLA**

Citizens say although humanitarian NGOs (Global Communities and Crusaders for Peace Organization) are promoting the fight against Ebola through their campaigns, complacency is still rife among citizens who do not practice safety measures.



## **BEST PRACTICES**

A radio report on healed Ebola patients on LACSA radio in Grand Bassa County, thrilled its audience and prompted the General Agriculture and Allied Workers Union of Liberia (GAAWU) to step into the County with huge material assistance to all healed Ebola patients.

LACSA radio is community radio station that has beefed up its ability to effectively report rumors and keep citizens safe from Ebola.

### **RECOMMENDATIONS**

- 1. Citizens themselves are recommend that there is need for more EVD awareness in their communities, suggesting that *Attare shops*, palm wine bars and video clubs are well-suited open discussion platforms that directly target family heads and shape home-based perceptions on Ebola-related constraints.
- 2. Health and environment workers could jointly organize outreach exercises that would dismiss fears of any potential Ebola outbreak as the rainy season approaches. Increased awareness on the need to reinforce the Ebola prevention measures could be necessary to build trust in the fight against Ebola.
- 3. Citizens recommend that the borders should be closed until Liberia, Guinea and Sierra Leone are all declared Ebola-free. They add that teachers and students could be trained by health authorities on the EVD preventive protocols.
- 4. In River Gee County, the citizens recommend that regular updates on the national Ebola press briefings held at the Information Ministry should be relayed to them via their local media channels.












